Common brands include CET, Greenies, and Hill's science diet.

Health Mouth is a water additive that helps prevent tartar buildup.

It's important to avoid chew toys that are harder than your pet's teeth.

Nylon bones, natural bones, and antlers can lead to fractured teeth.
